### We respect your right to privacy and protect the security of your data

Beyond.pl Sp. z o. o. guarantees the security of data, including personal data, owned by users who visit the <https://ai.beyond.pl/> website. The information set out below ensures that personal data is kept confidential and used appropriately.

The controller of personal data collected through the website <https://ai.beyond.pl/> is Beyond.pl Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Poznań (61-248), ul. Kręglewskiego 11, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs maintained by the District Court Poznań – Nowe Miasto i Wilda in Poznań, 8th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under KRS No. 0000237620 (hereinafter referred to as "Beyond.pl").

Beyond.pl has appointed its Data Protection Officer, whom you may contact in all matters concerning the processing of your personal data at the following address: [iod@beyond.pl](mailto:iod@beyond.pl).

As the User, you have the right to decide to what extent your data can be used by Beyond.pl. You have the following rights:

1. to request access to and rectification of your personal data,
2. to have your personal data erased or to restrict its processing,
3. to data portability,
4. to object at any time to the processing of your personal data, including profiling and direct marketing,
5. withdraw consent to the processing of personal data at any time, if the processing of the User's personal data is based on such consent; the withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out on the basis of that consent prior to its withdrawal,
6. to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, i.e., the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.

### Cookies

In order to make it easier to browse our website, we use cookies. Cookies are small text files that a website stores on the user's hard drive or in a web browser. A cookie typically contains the name of the domain from which it originates, the expiration date, i.e. how long it exists, and a unique randomly generated number used to identify the browser that connects to the website.

### Types of cookies

Beyond.pl uses the following categories of cookies:

- session cookies – stored on the user's telecommunication end device only until the user leaves the beyondsolutions.pl, website, closes the browser, or logs out of the website,
- persistent cookies – stored on the user's telecommunication end device for a specific period or until the user manually deletes them.

Our website the **Open Web Analytics (OWA)** analytics tool to analyze website traffic. **Open Web Analytics (OWA)** uses analytical cookies. These cookies are used exclusively for statistical purposes and to analyze how Users interact with our website.

OWA is analytics software installed directly on the Controller's server. The data collected by the system remains under the Controller's control and is not transferred to third parties.

OWA may store cookies on the user's device for the following purposes:

- recognise returning users;
- analyse website traffic statistics;
- monitor the manner in which the website is used.

As part of OWA's operations, the following data regarding website users may be processed:

- IP address,
- device and browser information (user agent),
- information regarding user interactions with the website, including page views, clicks, navigation paths and time spent on individual pages,
- data on traffic sources and campaigns,

Due to the configuration of the OWA system, data collected while using the website may be linked to a specific user or to the organisation represented by that user. This means that the Controller may identify users of the website and analyse their activity history, including, in particular, the pages visited, the duration and frequency of visits, actions performed and other information relating to the use of the website.

### Management of Consent

Our website uses a solution that allows users to manage their consent for cookies and similar technologies. Until consent is given, tools such as **Open Web Analytics (OWA)** are not activated.

Users may withdraw their consent, modify their preferences, or delete cookies from their browser at any time.

### Modifying cookie settings and deleting cookies

The majority of web browsers are set to automatically enable cookies by default. However, you can change browser settings so that the cookies are blocked – entirely or partly e.g. only third-party cookies – or so that you are notified each time cookies are stored on your device.

Please note that blocking or deleting certain cookies may affect the proper functioning of our website and limit the availability of certain features. It may also prevent us from collecting statistical data on how the website is used, which we use to continuously improve it.
